We are seeking 15-20 motivated young people from migrant and refugee backgrounds, or from new & emerging communities, to take part in this unique training opportunity!

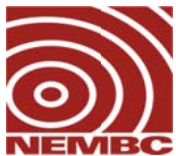
## What Will Participants Gain?

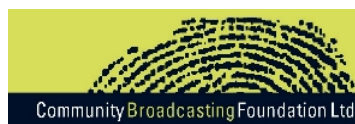
