### Training management

- From January 2020 the department will be managing the Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum (KS:CPC) training.

## Department requirements

- The KS:CPC is mandatory in all department sites for children and young people age 3 to year 12.
- Teachers that deliver the training must complete a full day training.
